- Please bring deluxe boards, Protiles, and game timers.
- All playing facilities are handicapped accessible. During room registration, please mention handicap needs.
- All hotel guests can use the hotel's pool and exquisite Regency Health Club for free. (pool, yoga & pilates classes, racquetball courts, free childcare while using the health care facilities, etc.)
- To defray the cost of the playing facilities, all playing attendees who are not staying at the hotel on the *SCRABBLE*[®] package are required to pay a \$15 commuter fee (one-day Newcomers and one-day CSW participants exempt from this fee).
- The first 25 entries will be eligible for an early-bird prize.
- BAT 2011 will present the annual "Robert Felt Memorial *Star* Student Award," a \$100 award to the student under 18 who places the highest in the tournament.
- Players unsure about Premier eligibility are asked to send the higher entry fee and \$15 will be reimbursed during registration if necessary. Please monitor web site for registration status.
- Please mail registration and fees before 28 March 2011. Entries postmarked after this date will be assessed a \$15 late fee.

Pairings will be in round-robin groups of six (with final KOTH); players who do not yet have a NASPA CSW rating are welcome and will be seeded according to their NASPA TWL rating (which will be their initial NASPA CSW rating).

2011 PREMIER DETAILS

Qualification for the Premier division is based on standard NASPA peak ratings from 19 April 2010 to 14 March 2011 with a space reserved for Amit Chakrabarti, the winner of the 2010 BAT "A" Division.

The Premier division will be closed to registration on 14 March 2011. Any players intending to play must register with all fees submitted *by this date*. No exceptions.
